Surcharges:

- Surcharge if you stay between Friday and Sunday: € 10 per person per night
- Minimum stay is 3 nights – otherwise with short-stay surcharge: € 10 per person per night
- Room 1/1 or »single use« in a double room: € 30
- Surcharge for dinner on 31 Dec: € 50 adult, € 25 child (mandatory surcharge)
- Mountain view ****: € 20 per night
- Suite****: € 60 per night
- Child under the age of 6 staying in a room with two adults without separate bed stays FREE OF CHARGE
- Child under the age of 6 in a 3-star room with two adults on an extra bed € 45 per child per night (half-board included)
- Extra bed: € 20 per night
- Child under the age of 6 in a 4-star room with two adults on an extra bed € 55 per child per night (half-board included)
- Children's bed € 10 per night
- Tourist tax: € 2 per night

- **Families:** The Kranjska Gora ski pistes, only 6 km distant from the Špik Hotel, offer gentle descents that are ideal to start the ski season. Ski slopes are ideal for families with kids to introduce them to this attractive sport discipline.
- **Sport clubs:** Slovenia is a country of ski enthusiasts and the slopes in Kranjska Gora have been a testing ground for many of them. The 3-star Špik Hotel has also been the accommodation of choice for many.
- **Seasoned skiers:** Non distant from Kranjska Gora there are ski pistes in Italy (Tarvisio and Monte Lussary) and Austria (Dreiländereck/Gerlitz/Nassfeld). Do some warming-up on the ski slopes of Kranjska Gora. Then choose different ski slopes each day – skiing in three different countries!
- **Wellness enthusiasts:** The Špik Alpine Resort with its stylish World of Water and Saunas offers complete relaxation, including massage treatments. Extra on offer is the possibility to rent privately the Alpine Wellness with its five themed rooms.
- **Cross-country skiing lovers:** Zgornjesavska Valley offers great possibilities for cross-country skiing. The piste running from Rateče towards Planica and the Tamar Valley offers memorable views of the Julian Alps.
- **Gourmets:** The Montana Restaurant in the Korona is surely worth a visit!
